SEATING CONSIDERATIONS

STYLES TO CONSIDER

Benches with Backs and Arms

- Suitable for all general seating areas
- Creates defined seating space, especially on benches with intermediate arm rests.
- Arms aid in rising out of the seated position
- Contoured seat and angled back create comfort for longer periods of seating

Backless Benches with No Armrests

- Allows for seating from both sides
- Uninterrupted landscape views
- Use the flat top at picnic tables for more upright positioning

Benches with Back, No Arms

- Use for fixed seating at game tables
- Allows for greater seating capacity
- Use end to end for continuous seating runs

Arms Rest Inserts

- Use to create additional separation where there is no bench leg
- Available for 1939 and 1964 World's Fair models
- Prevents people from lying on benches
