ANCHORING GARDEN BENCHES

PREPARING FOR ANCHORING

- Garden benches are appropriate for private and public use.
- Classical and simple designs blend into many landscapes.
- Durable surfaces for decades of maintenance free use.
- Supplied in 3 pieces – two support legs and one top.
- The tops are prepared with threaded inserts which will accept an anchor rod. This sets into a prepared hole in the support legs, add anchoring cement for a secure installation.
- The support leg hole also allows a rod to connect the leg to a footing.
- Simple placement on prepared hard surfaces.



PLANNING THE FOOTING

- Each bench style has pre-set anchor locations, refer to our bench drawings to prepare your footing.
- **Select your footing style:**
 - *Full concrete pad*
 - *Rectangular pads directly under each support leg.*
 - *Crushed stone*
 - *Direct on pavers*
- Placement in soft terrain such as grass or wood chips is not suggested for the long term, the bench will sink over time.
- Footings can be smaller than support leg profile, use this method when placement in grassy areas is desired.
