## WARRANTY INFORMATION

Lynch Estate Elements strives to be the single source of classic garden ornamentation for discerning clientele. With our superior product knowledge and commitment to conserving the practices on which our reputation was built, we are ready to provide the next generation of heirloom estate ornaments to the next generation of discerning clientele.

## WARRANTY FOR ESTATE ELEMENTS

Cast stone fountains and ornaments are warranted for a period of 2 years against defects in workmanship resulting in cracks 1/8" wide or more and spalling with material separation. Normal wear includes the top layer of slurry weathering to expose the natural stone aggregate and some crazing and/or fine hairline cracks.

**Lead fountains and ornaments** are warranted for a period of 2 years against defects in workmanship resulting in cracking or welds opening. Normal wear includes the dark grey wax weathering to a matte finish ashen grey.

**Bronze fountains, ornaments and sundials** are warranted for a period of 10 years against defects in workmanship resulting in cracked welds. Patinas are coated with a clear lacquer, normal wear includes the gradual wearing of this coating, allowing the patina to deepen naturally. **Weathervanes** are warranted for a period of 5 years against defects in workmanship resulting in cracked welds. Modifying the prescribed installation will void the warranty.

All products: Suitability of use is responsibility of purchaser. Installation errors and on-site plumbing connections are responsibility of installer.

Such warranty shall be honored by replacement or repair, at the option of Kenneth Lynch & Sons, of the defective product with the same product or similar product if the original product is no longer available, F.O.B. Oxford, Connecticut, only, provided that:

- (a) Written notice describing the defect is given by the Buyer to Kenneth Lynch & Sons and Kenneth Lynch & Sons consents in writing to shipment of the product, freight prepaid, to its factory in Oxford, Connecticut, by the Buyer; or
- (b) Proof of defect satisfactory to Seller is provided to it by written description and photographs or other visual aids; and
- (c) Kenneth Lynch & Sons determines to its satisfaction that such a product is defective in workmanship or material.

## Warranties are limited as follows:

- (d) The product must have been used in accordance with the use for which it was designed as well as all recommended installation procedures were followed.
- (e) Defective parts of any product shall be supplied by Kenneth Lynch & Sons. The cost of removal of such defective parts and the cost of its replacement shall be borne by the Buyer.
- (f) This warranty is the sole warranty of the Kenneth Lynch & Sons and NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR USE OR OF ANY OTHER KIND OF NATURE ARE MADE.

**PRODUCT SUITABILITY:** Determination of the suitability of Kenneth Lynch & Sons product for the uses and applications contemplated by the Buyer are the sole responsibility of the Buyer. Buyer assumes all risk and liability for the use or application of Kenneth Lynch & Sons products, whether used singly or in combination with other products.

**CLAIM PERIOD:** Claims related to non-conforming product shall be made by written notice within ten (10) days after delivery. All other claims shall be made within the specified product's length of warranty from the date of invoice. Buyer's failure to give Kenneth Lynch & Sons written notice of any claim within the applicable period shall constitute an absolute and unconditional waiver of such claim.

**MAINTENANCE:** Routine maintenance is suggested to be performed yearly by the end user; including inspection of fasteners, solid connections to footings, wall mounted hardware intact, plumbing connections have no visible leaks.

- Follow our recommend fountain winterization tips.
- Cast stone can be left to age naturally with no specified cleaning process. If the end user wishes to have 'bright' cast stone please use our maintenance guide.
- Lead ornaments can be left to age naturally. Do not use harsh chemicals in or near lead as it will affect the patina. Specifically avoid using chlorine, acid and vinegar in lead fountains. Follow our maintenance guide to apply a fresh wax coating.
- Bronze items require no maintenance. Allow to age and patina.
- Weathervanes should be visibly inspected to ensure the ornament is rotating freely, the direction indicators are stationary and the entire assembly is vertical.
