IRON BENCHES

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

- Bench supports are made of ductile iron, a foundry formulation characterized by high strength, flexibility, and durability.
- Iron is powder coated for maximum durability in high traffic areas.
- All benches use the same dimensional size lumber allowing slats to be used anywhere on the seat or back area.
- Stainless steel hardware includes tamper resistant nuts to prevent slat removal.
- Simple assembly process with minimal parts allows for ease of maintenance.
- Securely anchor benches by using the provided holes in the contact points.



A BRIEF HISTORY

Kenneth Lynch & Sons was the initial fabricator of the 1938/1939 World's Fair in New York City. This event brought us into bench fabrication and also established our firm as a reliable source for the New York City Parks department. Since that time, we have maintained our relationship with NYC Parks as well as developed strong ties to many parks which were designed by Fredrick Law Olmsted.
